- Kansas State University is the only public university since 1986 to rank among the top 10 of all U.S. schools for all five of these major scholarship programs: Rhodes, Marshall, Truman, Goldwater and Udall.

- K-State ranks first nationally among all 500 state universities in Truman and Goldwater and is tied for third in Udall scholarship competition since each foundation began awarding scholarships. K-State ranks second in Rhodes and is tied for second in Marshall competition since 1986.

- K-State is tied for third nationally in Goldwater, is sixth in Truman and is tied for fifth in Udall competition among all of the 2,000 four-year colleges and universities in America - 500 public; 1,500 private.

- The Truman Foundation recognized K-State in 1996 as a Truman Scholarship Honor Institution, the first time the Foundation singled out universities for their achievements in Truman competition. Only 17 schools were chosen from the 454 colleges and universities which have produced Truman scholars.
